Bike

There won't be a bike familiarization schedule. Instead, the organization will provide a video of the bike course on Google Earth. The part of the bike course that goes out of Avlu (the Race Venue) usually has heavy traffic. During the races, only one part of the road will be used. The athletes that want to train on the bike course will be at their own risk.

2.3. ATHLETE'S LOUNGE

The Athlete's Lounge will be located in Avlu, Balıkesir, next to the Transition Zone and 400m from the Start Area. It will provide toilets and water. Bike mechanic service will be provided in the EXPO ZONE, which will be located 100m from the Athlete's Lounge. A recovery zone will be placed next to the finish area. Both zones will have been constructed under the Covid-19 restrictions. Massage service will not be provided.

2.4. ELITE & JUNIOR ATHLETES' RACE PACKAGE

Race packages will be distributed on:

• Thursday, July 29th from 15:00 to 19:00

and

Friday, July 30th from 09:00 to 13:00

Composition of Race Package:

- Helmet numbers (3) & Bike number (1)
- Body decals for both arms & legs 4 x sets
- Accreditation card

Registration fees and antigen test costs are as follows:

Elite: € 100,00 (pre-race antigen test included)
Junior: € 80,00 (pre-race antigen test included)

2.5. DOPING CONTROL

Location of the doping control site. The location will be next to the transition area. Doping tests will be conducted according to World Triathlon/WADA rules. The athletes must carry their identification to the doping control facilities.

2.6. SECURITY

The Venue area will be secured by a professional and licensed security company. Road closures and traffic around the area will be managed by the Police. There will be ambulances at the venue and on the bike course. On the swim course there will be lifeguards and rescuers. About 20 volunteers will also be involved in the events.

5. ATHLETE'S SERVICES

5.1. TRAINING FACILITIES



A part of the canal, between the starting pontoon and exit ramp, will be available for training from July 27th to July 29th between 09:00-11:00 and 17:00-19:00. There will be lifeguards on site, but swimming pool lanes are not available. The swimming sessions are free of charge.



No specific bike roads are provided. The road around the venue will be open to traffic till the race day.



Track & Field Stadium

 İsmail Akçay Athletics Track, open to public use, has administrative offices, large and small sports halls that can be used in rainy weather, warehouses, locker rooms and showers. Inner lane 400 meters, outer lane 450 meters.

5.2. MEDICAL SERVICES

First Aid and Emergency Medical Services will be available at the Registration area before and during the familiarisations and during the race. There will be First Aid and Emergency Medical Services at the Race Venue on competition day.







Medical and Paramedical personnel will be available throughout the race. Paramedics will be mobile on the bike course and run course. 2 (Two) ambulances will be available to provide emergency transfers to a nearby hospital. A medical area will be provided on site at the finish area. Medical services at the venue are free of charge. Treatment in private hospitals are to be paid by participants. Athletes / teams should make sure that they have appropriate medical insurance.

On race day athletes will be given a timing chip, to be worn on the athletes' ankle. Athletes will pick up the timing chips before the competitions, during their check-in procedure.

7. ACCREDITATION

The LOC will provide to all the Organizing Committee Members, WT Technical Officials, Athletes, VIPs, media, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, etc. with an official Accreditation Card. Due to the Covid-19 World Triathlon restrictions, only 1 coach and 1 medical personnel per category for each NF can be accredited through the WT process.

Accreditation cards of Elite & Junior athletes, coaches and medical personnel will be distributed during the race package pick-up on Thursday, July 29th and Friday, July 30th, at the Avlu Congress Centre. Specific appointments will be communicated to the teams the week before the event.

Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. Accreditation Cards provide access to specific areas of the competition areas. All accredited people are requested to carry their Accreditation Cards with them at all times and to show them upon request. Accreditation Cards are mandatory to enter the venue.

9. COURSE MAPS

SWIM START

Start procedures: deep-water start, holding the pontoon. Depth at the start: 1,5m.

The Race Referee with assistance of Technical Officials, who are assigned to the start, will start each race.



SWIM COURSE

Number of laps: 1 (one), Distance to the first turning buoy: 510m,

Average water temperature: 23-25°C



TRANSITION 1

A flow through transition has been developed to keep athletes moving forward. Athletes enter the transition and must deposit swim gear in a bin placed beside the bike racks. Athletes' names and







numbers are displayed on the top of each bike rack. After the helmet is secured, athletes unrack the bike by moving forward into the centre lane and towards the mount line.





Number of laps: 4, Lap length: 5 km, Surface: Asphalt, Quality: very good Team Wheel station: It will be located near transition, in a place where athletes pass at the end of each lap.Neutral Wheel station: It will be located after the U-turn, at the furthest point of the bike course.










TRANSITION 2

After the last lap of the bike, athletes have to get off the bike before the dismount line. They run by holding the bike, turning right to enter the TA. Athletes enter the transition and must deposit the bike. Running shoes may be placed beside the rack or in the box. After this they should proceed to the run course.



*RUN COURSE

Number of laps: 3

Description: flat, mostly tartan and some parts are concrete.

One water station 150m after T2. The Penalty Box is located just before the transition.









10. COVID-19 MEASUREMENTS FOR ATHLETES AND COACHES

1. Travel

2. Airport Transfer

Anyone using the shuttles provided by the LOC must be informed that the use of a mask and/or face covering is mandatory. Everyone needs to disinfect their hands before entering the bus.

3. Accommodation

Use of mask and face coverings is mandatory in the hotels, keep social distancing and disinfect hands in hotel's public places.

4. Training sites

Athletes are recommended to keep distance during running sessions and during their session in the swimming pool. Overall recommendation is to try to have those sessions in the morning to avoid peak times.

5. Testing protocol and health screening

- All individuals (except for the LOC, its volunteers and contractors) applying for an accreditation to World Triathlon and Continental Triathlon events must respect the following conditions:
 - Fill in the online pre-event questionnaire through the World Triathlon website.
 - Perform an Antigenic or PCR swap pre- travel test 72 hours before the athletes' travel to
 the event or no later than 6 days before the event for local athletes/team support and
 NTOs. Tests that must currently be taken to gain entry to a country are valid as pre-travel
 tests
- Additionally to this, all elite/junior triathletes must submit a pre-travel medical certificate according to the requirements above
- Finally, all elite/junior athletes, coaches, team medical and support NF personnel must perform an Antigenic pre-race test before entering the Venue. In case of a positive result, a PCR swab test must follow. Time and place for these tests will be determined by the LOC.

• Athletes who have recovered from COVID-19 prior to the competition It is recognised that those who recovered from COVID-19 may still be at risk of returning a positive test, despite no contagion risk or symptoms.

To be permitted to take part in subsequent competition any athlete who has recovered from COVID-19 must submit a medical document to the Medical Delegate, which confirms full recovery from COVID-19. This information will be reviewed by the Medical Committee and be decided if the athlete can participate or not.

The documentation must include:

- The date of initial diagnosis (the date of first symptoms should be at least 7 days before the competition with at least one day without any symptom)
- Relevant medical history in English
- The result of at least 1 negative COVID-19 test (PCR or antigen) in accordance with the health care regulations of the respective country within 14 days of the commencement of the intended competition.

7. Race package distribution

Each team delegation will be given a certain date and time (appointment) in order to have the mandatory Antigen Test and Race-pack distribution. The appointments will be communicated the week before the event.

Athletes, coaches and medical personnel should carry their passports.

The use of masks and social distancing is mandatory.

8. Health screening

Temperature checks will be performed every time the athletes and coaches are on site including at the times of the athletes' package distribution and familiarizations. A temperature above 38°C will be reported to the RMD.

9. Competition activities

- a. The mask should be worn until the last minute before athletes' introduction. Please make sure that you will wear your mask after the warm-up
- b. Wheel stations:
- At the neutral wheel stations, all wheels will be disinfected before being delivered to the specific locations. An athlete in need of a spare wheel will be directed by the TO to the proper wheel which can be picked up by the athlete.
- At the team wheel station, the volunteers and TOs present at that location must not have any contact with the team wheels. The team representatives are responsible for disinfecting the wheels prior to depositing them at the wheel station. An athlete in need of a spare wheel will be directed by the TO to the proper wheel which can be picked up by the athlete.
- In both cases, the wheel that is left behind by the athlete will be disinfected by the TO before being deposited at the station.
- Technical officials will wear masks/mouth-nose face covering and rubber/disposable gloves
- c. Finish Area
 - Timing chip removal must be done by the athlete, who must deposit the timing chip to a specific bin close to the exit of the post-finish area.
 - Medalist photo at the post-finish area is not allowed.
 - All recovery stations will be self-served.
- Food provided will be individually wrapped.
- Massage facilities will not be provided.







- Athletes must avoid lying or sitting down on the blue carpet (without any medical need/problems). A minimum number of volunteers will be available to support the athletes and make sure that the athletes are not congregating at the post finish area. These volunteers will wear rubber/disposable gloves and masks/mouth-nose face covering.
- Masks will be distributed to the athletes to wear at their earliest convenience.
- d. Medal Ceremonies

Medal ceremonies will be performed according to the COVID-19 guidelines for medal ceremonies that can be found on the <u>World Triathlon COVID-19 Guidelines for Event Organizers.</u>

10. Spectators' access

The event will be open to spectators. Any non-accredited person can watch the event from the spectator's areas.

11. Accreditation

Per team, only one accreditation for coach and one for medical are allowed.

12. All facilities used by the athletes will be cleaned and disinfected by the LOC through the day.

13. COVID-19 medical protocols

• Protocols to be followed in case of a positive case:

If the Antigen test is positive, the person will be placed in an isolation room and have the PCR test. If the PCR test is negative, the person will be released and can continue to the next steps for race package delivery

If the PCR test is positive, the person involved, and all his/her close contacts, must be placed in isolation.

Depending on the symptoms, the isolation will be in a hotel room or hospital.

Costs of isolation and any tests after having a positive PCR test should be covered by the respective federation.

• Development of symptoms during competition

If any participant develops high fever, dry cough, fatigue, breathlessness, headache, diarrhea or loss of sense of taste and/or smell, must immediately quarantine her/himself at their hotel and contact Chief Medical.

A PCR test will be done. If negative, the participant will be released, if positive, and depending on the symptoms, the participant will stay in a hotel or will be taken to hospital.
